Reading of the Law: The Ten Commandments (Exodus 20:1-20)

Minister: And God spoke all these words, saying, "I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery.

All: You shall have no other gods before me.

Minister: You shall not make for yourself a carved image ... You shall not bow down to them or serve them ...

All: You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain, for the Lord will not hold him guiltless who takes his name in vain.

Minister: Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy ... the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.

All: Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be long in the land that the Lord your God is giving you.

Minister: You shall not murder.

All: You shall not commit adultery.

Minister: You shall not steal.

All: You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.

Minister: You shall not covet your neighbor's house ... or anything that is your neighbor's ... Moses said to the people,

All: Do not fear, for God has come to test you, that the fear of him may be before you, that you may not sin.
